

Box Elder School District First Generation College Student Concurrent Enrollment Scholarship Application

Purpose: The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage students whose parents have not graduated from a college or university (baccalaureate degree, or higher) to begin their college experience while still in high school. The scholarship will cover the cost of admission, tuition, books, and materials associated with concurrent enrollment courses available in our school district. This scholarship will be applicable to all concurrent enrollment courses taken while the student is enrolled as a full-time student in Box Elder School District.

Eligibility: Any full-time Box Elder School District student who can certify they are a first generation college student, are a junior or senior, and have met the academic admission requirements (cumulative grade point average of 3.00, or better, or an ACT composite score of 22) is eligible to apply.*

*Students who do not meet the academic requirement of grade point average or ACT score may be eligible for a waiver of these requirements. Please see your school counselor for details.
